BUILD. LEARN. RIDE.

GETTING PEOPLE WHO NEED BIKES ON SAFE BIKES

794 safe-to-ride bikes sold at no- or low-cost, 50% of whom use bikes as their primary form of transportation for work, groceries, family and school.

FIXING BIKES FOR FREE

780 Learn & Repair sessions hosted, where participants work 1:1 with a BT mechanic to fix their bike with BT tools, used parts and accessories, all while learning the skills to do so on their own. Cost-flexible for any budget down to zero.

PARTNERING IN COMMUNITY

BT joined 39 community events, serving 1,765 participants, and engaged with 50 partners, including Bike Repair Clinics and workshops with Denver Public Libraries, Denver Public Schools, and Westwood Bike Library, Montbello Bikefest, Denver Housing Authority, Globeville Rec Center and Girls Scouts, among others.

EDUCATING

Bikes Together hosted 136 Bike Mechanics classes, (including specialty Spanish and Gender Equity Mechanic Series), taught by our professional mechanic team, 80% of whom are also from an underrepresented bike community, identifying as female, non-binary, LGBTQIA+ and/or BIPOC. We also hosted two high school interns and workshops.

ENGAGING VOLUNTEERS

86 active volunteers contributed over 2,600 hours in all aspects of the organization.

RESHAPING THE BIKE CULTURE

One of our core unique offerings is monthly Gender Equity Mechanics drop-in sessions where women, trans, nonbinary and femme folks come together with women, trans, nonbinary and femme mechanics to center a culture of learning, solidarity and accessible cycling for all, at no cost (Oh yeah, these GEM nights are also free!)

DIVERTING BIKES FROM LANDFILL

Over 1,700 bikes were donated to Bikes Together in 2025 and we diverted almost 26 tons (that's right!) from landfill through repurposing and recycling bikes and components.

SUPPORTING IT ALL WITH A MAGICAL RETAIL + SERVICE SHOP

In our small but mighty retail and professional service shop in the La Alma-Lincoln Park neighborhood, we generated \$450,000 of revenue within our social enterprise model. Not only is our shop just a great bike shop that celebrates the joy of biking for all people, retail dollars (along with our donors!), make all this impact possible.
